

I-MBA SAILING CLUB – TERMS AND REGULATIONS

CHAPTER 1: TITLE, PURPOSE, VISION & MISSION

Name of the Club

It is called I-MBA Sailing Club and it is part of the I-MBA Alumni. I-MBA Alumni is the Alumni Association of the graduates students of the Decision Sciences Masters programme of the Department of Management Science & Technology (DMST) of the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB) and the graduates and current students of the International MBA programme.

Purpose of the Club

To encourage and promote sailing, outdoor activities, social events and charity events in all its aspects

Vision of the Club

To be recognized by all members and the University community as a **premier Sport and social club**, a Club of which members would be proud to claim membership and which others will aspire to join

Mission of the Club

The mission of the Club is to start sailing, or continue sailing, participate in various cruising events, various sport and outdoor activities, social events, charity events, compete in international sailing events against the most famous business schools in the world and above all extend your networks and enhance the bonding among students and alumni of International MBA

CHAPTER 2: MEMBERS, OBLIGATIONS & RIGHTS

Members of the Club

All I-MBA current students or I-MBA Alumni can be members of the I-MBA Sailing Club.

Registration Procedure

In order to become a member of the Club, someone has to express his/her interest by filling in the registration form and submit it either to the I-MBA Secretariat, or to the Sailing Captain or via email to the sailing@i-mbalumni.com. The management of the Club has to right to approve or deny the registration form and within a few days from the submission, if approved, he/she will receive a "Welcome" email from the I-MBA Sailing Club, which would verify his/her registration. From this day, he/she is considered as member of the Club and will be informed in a regular basis about all the activities of the Club.

Membership fee

There is no membership fee.

Members' obligations

Everyone who becomes member of the Club automatically accepts the regulations of the Club and agrees to respect the Club and its purpose in every activity or event of the Club. In case of inappropriate behaviors, the management of the Club has the right to exclude a member from an activity/event of the Club or even remove him/her from the I-MBA Sailing Club Community.



CHAPTER 3: MANAGEMENT OF THE CLUB

The Sailing Captain

The I-MBA Sailing Club is managed by the Sailing Captain. The Sailing Captain must be either an I-MBA current student or a member of the I-MBA Alumni. The role of the Sailing Captain is to promote the Club to the I-MBA students and Alumni, to organize various sailing and other activities throughout the year and to build an I-MBA Sailing Team which can participate in local and international sailing races. The Sailing Captain has to inform the President of the I-MBA Alumni Association for all issues of the Club, whenever he/she is asked to do so. All Sailing Captains and the President of the I-MBA Alumni Association are considered as honorary members of the Club.

Elections of the Sailing Captain

Every year, an I-Sailing Meeting is organized, in order to discuss about various issues of the Club and elect the new Sailing Captain. Every member of the Club can express his/her interest to become candidate for the role of the Sailing Captain; all candidates must be either suggested or approved by the Sailing Captain of the Club and/or the honorary members of the Club. The final candidates are announced to all members of the Club and the new Sailing Captain is elected by the members of the Club. In case of unexpected circumstances, the President of the I-MBA Alumni can decide to announce elections of the new Sailing Captain before the annual I-Sailing Meeting. The Sailing Captain can be re - elected for maximum 3 continuous times.

The Sailing Assistant

The Sailing Captain may choose a Sailing Assistant, who is going to help him/her in the organization of the activities/events of the Club. The Sailing Assistant must be either an I-MBA current student or a member of the I-MBA Alumni.

CHAPTER 4: ACTIVITIES OF THE CLUB & PARTICIPATION RULES

Activities of the Club

- <u>Sailing Courses:</u> You can attend sailing courses and obtain sailing diploma in cooperation with a well known Hellenic Sailing Organization with a significant discount.
- <u>Sailing Weekends:</u> The I-MBA Sailing Club organize sailing weekends, in order for the participants to make practice in sailing, enjoy the sea and above all enhance the bonding among students/alumni.
- <u>Sailing Races:</u> Our I-MBA Sailing Team works hard throughout the year to practice in order to compete in international sailing events against the most famous business schools.
- Social Events
- Outdoor sport activities
- Charity events

Participation in the activities of the Club

As the I-MBA Sailing Club is part of the I-MBA Alumni Association, in order to participate in an activity of the Club, you have to:

- 1. be a current I-MBA student or
- 2. be an active member of the I-MBA Alumni Association (which means having paid both registration and annual subscription fees of the I-MBA Alumni Association)

and you have to become a member of the Club through the aforementioned registration procedure.

In some cases, non I-MBA friends of the I-MBA students/alumni can participate in the activities of the Club, but the final decision is up to the Sailing Captain and the Sailing Assistant to decide, based on the priority of the I-MBA students, the first-in first-served rule and the current demand for the specific event.

Note: If you are member of the Club, you have graduated from the I-MBA program but you have not paid your supporting fees to the I-MBA Alumni Association, you will be informed about the activities of the Club, but if you decide to participate in an activity of the Club, you will have to pay your obligations to the I-MBA Alumni Association.



Participation fee

For every activity of the Club, there will be a participation fee, which must be paid before the activity. When the final list of the participants is ready, they receive an email/message with all the information needed to know about the event. From this time, they can pay their participation fee through the various ways of payments of the I-MBA Alumni Association. In the payment procedure, It must always be written: [Sailing]+[DateOfEvent]+[FullName] and when the payment is implemented, an information email must be sent to the sailing@i-mbalumni.com. Unregister Procedure
